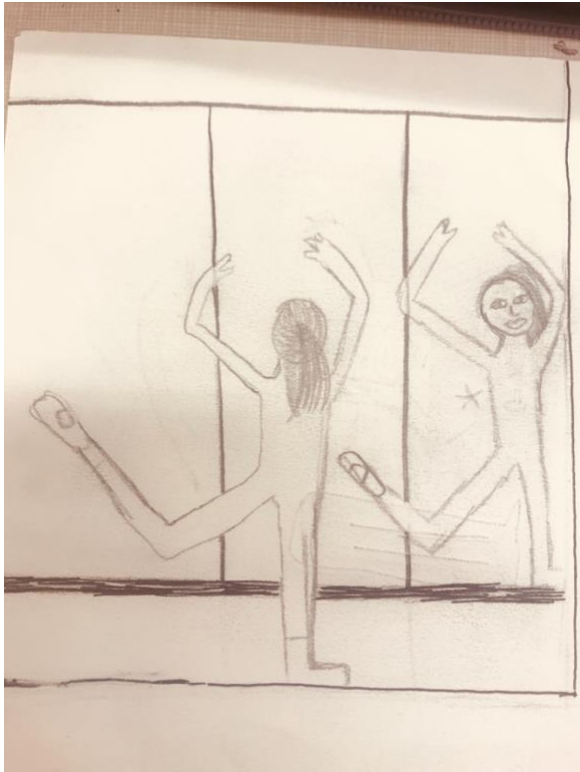


S4: STORYBOARDING

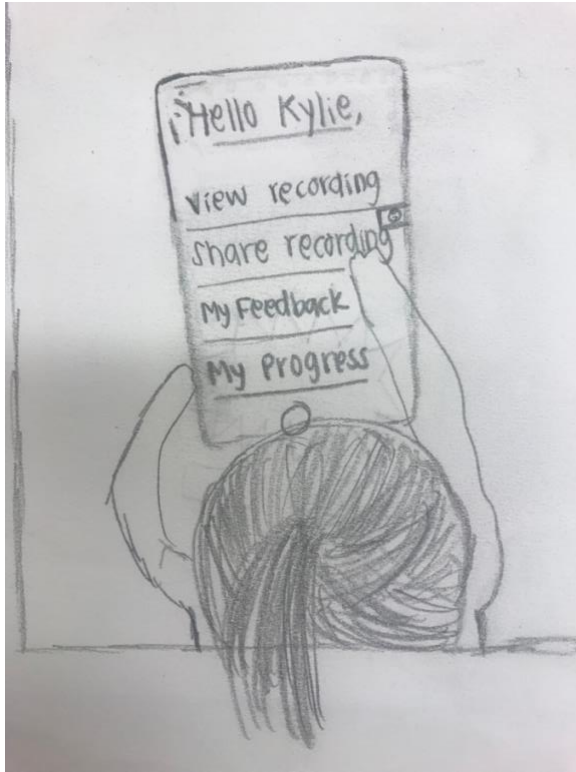
Project Description

- better memorization



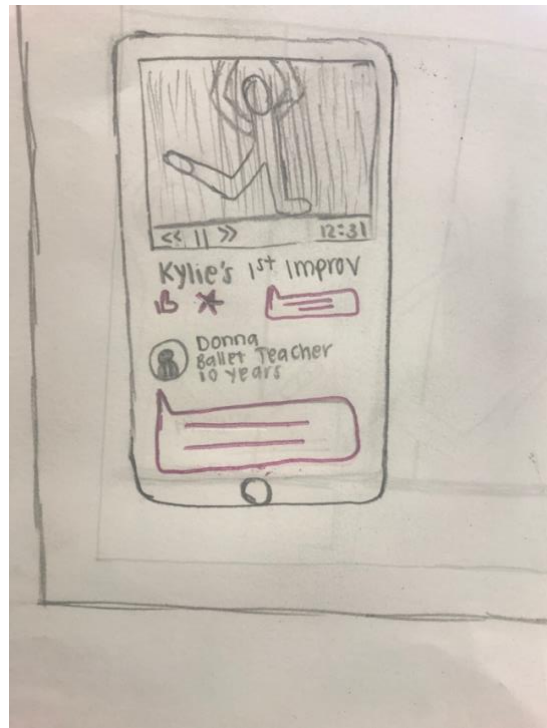
1. The user is practicing their dance moves in the mirror.



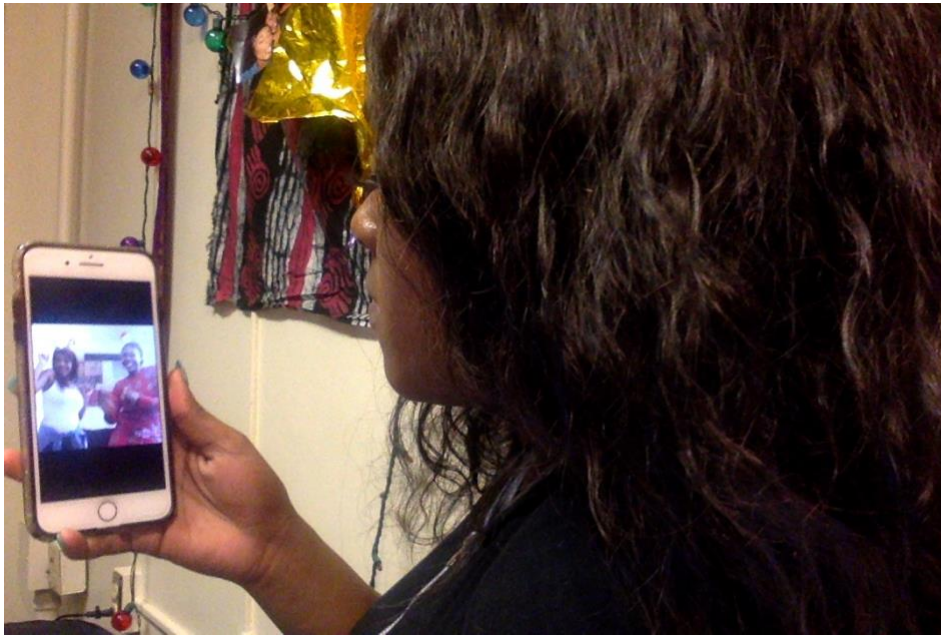
2. The user opens the Spotlight application to share their recording.



3. User receives feedback in when she opens the app.



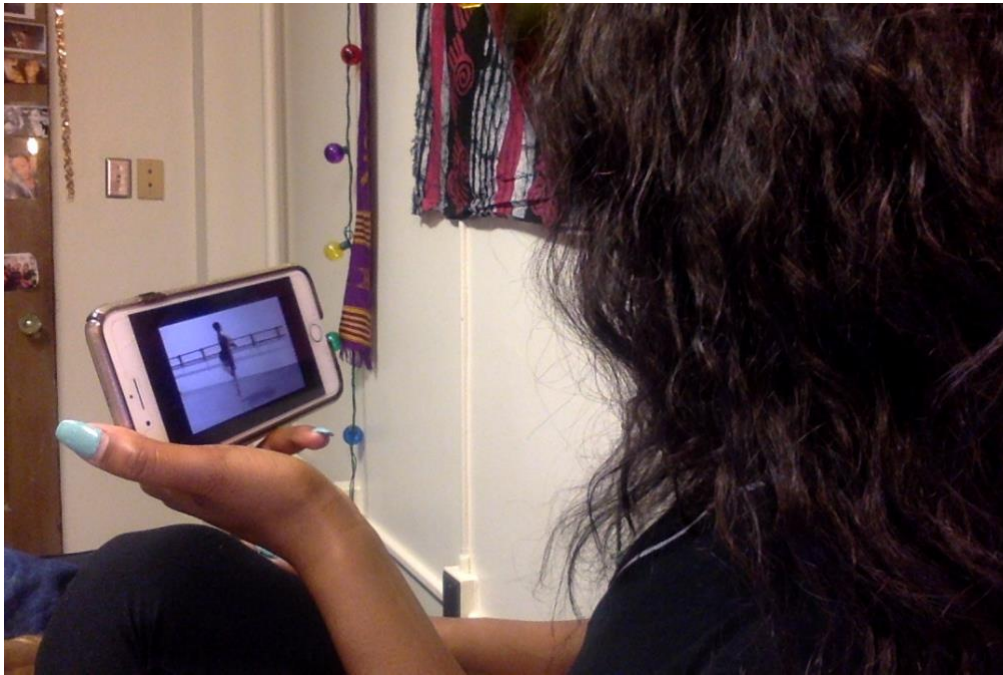
4. User views feedback and has the option to favorite the comment for the tracking of progress.



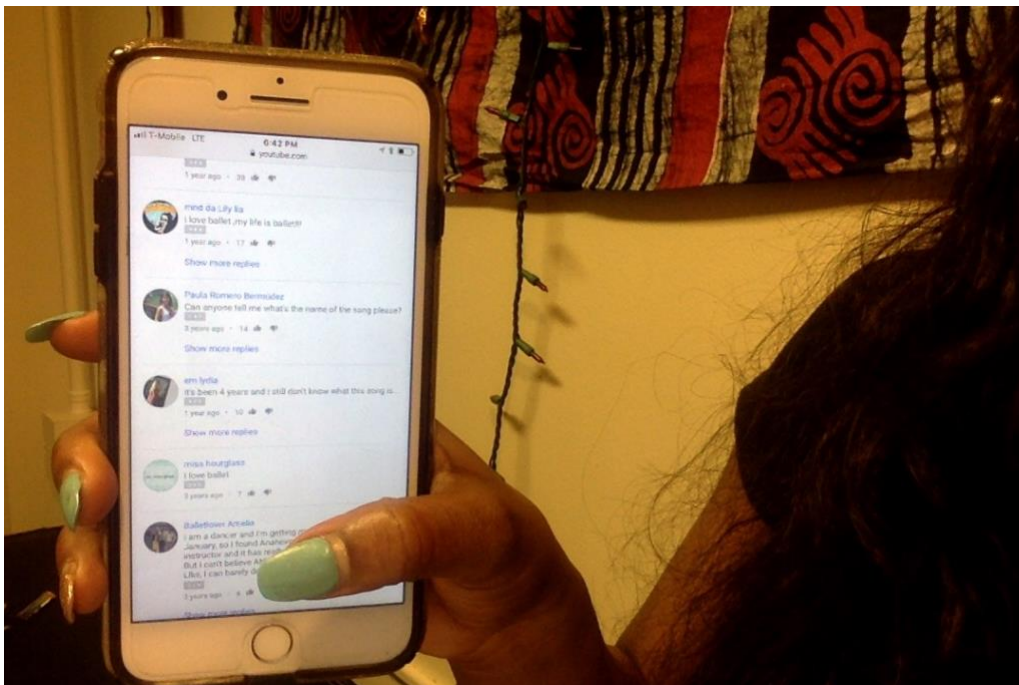
The user has a choreographed dance that she would like to upload and share with others.
